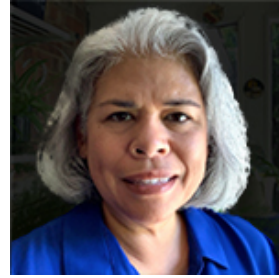

Lijo Abraham, N.P.

HHM nurse practitioner Lijo Abraham is a healthcare hero. Lijo is from India and got her BSN degree in Arizona at Grand Canyon University. She wanted to help those who were in need of quality healthcare and came to work at Healing Hands in December of 2019. Lijo sees 20-25 patients each day for regular checkups, sick visits, lab analysis and more. One day a patient came in and asked to see Lijo. The patient was grey colored and communicated that he was dizzy and not feeling well. She listened to his heart and could tell that his heart rate was very low, so she performed an EKG. The patient had a 100% heart blockage. She knew he needed to be seen immediately in the ER and was extremely worried that at any time his heart could stop. Lijo took his abnormal EKG, put the man in her car and drove him to the ER at Texas Health Presbyterian hospital. They saw him upon arriving at the ER. Her quick, calm thinking saved this gentleman's life.
